Spring Maths Challenge

Each term Mrs Dalby-Bellis will be setting a whole school maths project. All children who participate will receive some merit points and will be entered into a prize draw to win a Maths puzzle game.

This terms challenge is: a time challenge.

Can you investigate time? What can you find out? Here are some ideas but remember you can choose to do whatever interests you. Parents are encouraged to help.

Reception: Could you order some of the activities you do in a day? Could you sort activities by those that take a long time and those that take a short time?

Key Stage 1: You could: use a stopwatch and find out how long activities take, keep a diary, investigate the different months of the year and things that happen in them, find out about the seasons and how they change, find out the times that you do some activities like bedtime, bathtime etc, take photos of the different clocks you find when you are out and about.

Key Stage 2: You could use a bus or train time table to plan a journey, keep a diary, find out how long it takes to complete different activities, investigate record breaking times and compare them, work out the time differences in different countries, find out why the military use 24hr clock, find out how many days it would take you to watch your top ten favourite films.
