

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT : VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOLS

1. The name of the school is **Stanion Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School**.
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is **"The governing body of Stanion Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School"**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a) **1** Head Teacher
 - b) **2** parent governors (to be elected)
 - c) **1** LA governor
 - d) **1** staff governors (to be elected)
 - e) **7** foundation governors - 2 of whom should be eligible as parent governors
5. Total number of governors is **12**
6. Foundation governors are appointed by Peterborough Diocese Board of Education. One Foundation Governor shall be the Rector of Brigstock with Stanion should he or she be willing to serve.
7. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England, which includes respecting other faiths and in partnership with the church in the parish of Stanion and at diocesan level.

The school aims to serve the community of Stanion by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.
8. This instrument of Government comes into effect on **1 December 2012**
9. This instrument was made by order of Northamptonshire Local Authority on **27 November 2012**
