I can hold a pencil between my thumb and two fingers. PD MH 30-50

I hold a pencil near point between first two fingers and thumb and uses it with good control. PD MH 30-50

I sometimes give meaning to marks as I draw and paint. L W 30-50

I give meaning to marks I make as I draw, write and paint. L W 40-60

I can copy some letters, e.g. letters from their name. PD MH 30-50

I can write my name. L W 40-60

I show a preference for a dominant hand. PD MH 40-60

I begin to use anticlockwise movement and retrace vertical lines. PD MH 40-60

I am beginning to form recognisable letters. PD MH 40-60
