

This will now be a 'Stanion Community Reading Challenge' and we encourage all members of our school community to take part in sharing, reading and enjoying a range of different books across the year. We aim to read and embrace the new books being picked for us so that we can then share our thoughts and views on our display in the library as well as discuss the books with the children and encourage the pupils to enjoy them too.


