- **Update on PTA Account**
LM went through our Cashflow. Please see attached document.

Cookie Craft Sets - Laura Broughton (LB) had an idea of cookie/pizza craft sets. She shared this with the group and they look lovely. We discussed the option of doing heart shaped cookie packs for Valentine's Day for the children. LA spoke to LB about feasibility of doing this. We can look to do this as an Easter project.

Friday 24th March School Disco –Mrs Findlay and Mr Forsyth have kindly offered to do the disco. We agreed to do the same as last time with drinks/hot dog & glitter tattoo £5 per child. We will start selling tickets w/c 20th March. Parents signature required for the glitter tattoo.
Friday 31st March – Easter Assembly End of Term Bake Sale – announce winners of the Easter Hamper Raffle. Chocolate/craft items to be provided by PTA members. Donations to be brought into the office by Monday 20th March so we can put together. We will start selling tickets w/c 27th March and as parents come into assembly. The Village Hall/Church are looking to do an Easter Egg Hunt which we can share details via Parentmail.
W/C 24th April - Pre-loved Spring Sale – To put together a poster/Parentmail to send out w/c 20th March asking parents to bring in any items after the Easter holidays they would like to donate to the pre-loved sale. Ideally Stanion badged uniform, World Book Day costumes, Pudsey items and Christmas jumpers.
Friday 26th May – May Day Picnic/Bake Sale – We will host a bake sale and refreshments stand. The cost of the alcohol license is £21. Rob has applied and had the licence agreed for this date so we can sell refreshments including Pimms on the day if we want to.
